Entry to this Event: All juniors (under 18) are most welcome. There is no grading limit. Results will be sent for ECF Rapidplay grading and results, grades and photos may be used on the Kent Junior Chess Association website, www.kjca.org, and in the Press. Your details will be held on the KJCA database solely to inform you about junior chess events.

Sections: Ages as on 31 August 2010. Under 9, U11, U14 & U18: all part of 2010~11 Kent Junior Grand Prix (see later). If there are insufficient entries in any section, the Organisers reserve the right to combine sections.

Rates of Play: All sections are Swiss events: all competitors play every round. **U9 & U11**: 6 rounds of 30 minutes each. **U14 & U18**: 5 rounds of 40 minutes each. Clocks will be used in all sections. Help will be given to anyone unfamiliar with them. FIDE Rapidplay rules apply with the exception that players arriving after the start of any round may be deemed to have lost by default unless the controller can pair them satisfactorily and players whose opponents have not arrived must expect to be re-paired. Chief Arbiter's decisions will be final.

Individual Prizes: In the U9 section, the top 3 players and the top girl will win mini-trophies. In the other sections, there will be cash prizes for the top 3 players and the top girl and a mini-trophy for the winner. In the event of a tie cash prizes will be split. Total cash prizes in each section will be as follows: U11 £50; U14 £85; U18 £120. In a tie, the winner will be calculated from respective sums of opponents' scores. Prizes will not be awarded before the prize-giving. Kent-based players not collecting their prizes will forfeit them.

Team Prize: Scores from top 3 juniors from any school will count towards team trophy. In a tie, the winner will be decided by calculating respective sums of opponents' scores.

Food/Drinks: The KJCA Volunteer Mobile Catering team will be at this event and offer a selection of refreshments from snacks to hot food and drinks. Appearance for another team in an inter-County event will result in automatic disqualification. Multipliers for this event are as follows: U9GP: x7; U11GP: x7; U14GP: x8.4; U18GP: x8.4.

Kent Schools Grand Prix: Eligibility criteria are the same as in the Kent Junior GP. The prize-winners at the 2011 GP Final will, therefore, be the primary and secondary school with the highest total scores from its best 3 eligible players at each GP event.

End-of-Season Party: We hope all will stay and bring enough food and drink for their family plus one. The Grand Prix prize-giving will take place between 6 and 8pm.

Directions/Parking: TN13 1HU Sevenoaks School is on the A225 (High Street) to Tonbridge just south of the centre of Sevenoaks. From the M25 Junction 5, take the A21 southbound.
